GROW YOUR CAREER IN RURAL ICTORIA

There are several programs that support GPs, GP registrars and interns working in rural and regional Victoria. These programs give you access to educational, professional and skill development opportunities to meet the needs of the community.

+ Health Workforce Scholarship Program

Location eligibility: MMM 3 - 7

Bursaries and scholarships to support an increase in skills, capacity and scope of practice while you are working in private practice or nonstate government primary healthcare.

+ Medical Professional **Development (MPD) Program** Location eligibility: MMM 2 - 7

Supports the ongoing professional development and education of medical practitioners in rural and regional Victoria.

+ Education Support Grant (GP Fellowship Exam Preparation)

Location eligibility: MMM 2

Access educational resources to prepare for gaining fellowship of either the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) or the Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM). You can access this grant if you work in private or public health practice.
