SCHOLARSHIP FOR NEW UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Overview

The initiAIT scholarship is for new undergraduate students commencing in an AIT Bachelor Degree in the 2020 academic years. This scholarship is only available to domestic students. Recipients of this scholarship will be awarded a discount on their tuition fees—equivalent to 50% off the first term and 50% off the last term of their Bachelor degree.

Show Us How You Solve Problems

Our graduates gain employment after study because they are great problem solvers. Problems like: “what logo will create the best brand awareness?”, “what lighting will create the right mood in a scene,” “what shape will create a funny but pathetic monster the client wants?”, “what timing should be used to convey the emotion across?”, “how will virtual reality change this concept?”, or even, “what will be the best platform to build this app on?”

While you are at AIT, we will teach you these creative techniques and skills. We are looking to award scholarships to those already displaying a passion and focus. The task below is primarily designed to test your creative and problem-solving skills.

The Red’s Random Replicator (brief)

An entrepreneur is developing something she calls Red’s Random Replicator, (actually a kind of 3D printer), targeted at children 8 to 12 years. She hasn’t been able to get the prototype to work properly, so there is nothing to physically to show, but she needs to promote the concept. It is your job to generate an idea or ideas that will capture the public imagination in a promotion.

The promotion might be in print, a video or an app. You might concentrate on the logo or a mascot. You might create a brochure, or short advertisement, or game. We want to see how you planned and developed your ideas. You can use a combination of any of the following to get your idea across:

- Sketches / wireframes (A4 paper with a max of 7 sheets)
- Text (500–1,000 words)
- Photos (max seven—if printing, on A4 paper)
- Video (max 60 seconds)

What We’re Looking For...

- The ability to generate ideas and recognise those that work
- The ability to develop ideas further
- The ability to execute ideas

How It Will Be Judged

- Skill
- Effort
- Creativity

An applicant’s financial status or personal circumstances will not be taken into consideration in any way during the evaluation process.

Eligibility

Students who are eligible for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Be a domestic student (Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident)
- Applied to AIT directly and be commencing in 2020
- Not have undertaken any previous study at a tertiary level, excluding TAFE and extension studies undertaken as part of a year 12 program
- Meet all other eligibility criteria and entry requirements for AIT’s Bachelor Degree courses for the 2020 major intakes
- Complete the challenge brief as per details above

How Do I Apply:

You must submit the following documents:

- Completed scholarship Application Form
- Your creative work to meet the brief for The Red’s Random Replicator.

You can submit relevant documents by email (info@ait.edu.au), online at ait.edu.au/scholarships or personally to reception during the business hours: Monday–Friday, 8:30am–5pm.

Scholarship applications must be received by 5pm of the deadline.

Forfeit of Scholarship

Scholarships may be forfeited if the scholarship award winner:

- Fails to abide by the conduct rules outlined in the AIT student handbook
- Fails their examinations without good cause
- Resigns from their scholarship or discontinues their studies at AIT
- Commits a breach of any of the rules and conditions outlined in this document
