


## NEWMAN COLLEGE THE UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE

Growth in mind and heart and soul is the aim of Newman College. The aspirations of the Collegiate tradition are reflected and fostered in a wonderful building designed by Walter Burley Griffin. Modern facilities, tutorials and scholarships encourage excellence in studies, while sport, music, drama, art and community service all express the variety of gifts to be found in College life. Newman College is a coeducational residential College affiliated to the University of Melbourne. The College has a Catholic foundation and is administered by the Jesuit Order. The College's fundamental purpose is to foster the intellectual, ethical and spiritual life of its members, to enable them to become effective leaders in the community, mature in faith and committed to justice. Newman College is open to all students, irrespective of their faith. Each year, around one third of Newman residents are engaged in graduate (coursework and research) and postgraduate studies in a total Newman community of 300 students.

Since its foundation in 1918, the College, through the generosity of a number of benefactors, has been able to offer scholarships and bursaries to many of its students. These are paid by a reduction in fees. Some students are also able to obtain paid part-time employment in the College.

## **Academic Scholarships and Bursaries**

Scholarships and bursaries are open to domestic and international applicants, and all graduate and postgraduate resident students accepted into Newman College automatically receive a scholarship of \$3,000 per annum. Further scholarships and bursaries are available and awarded on the basis of university results, financial circumstances and contributions to the community. Our fees for graduate and postgraduate students include residency for the full calendar year – 52 weeks. Also included are three daily meals and the extensive academic, social, IT, sporting and cultural opportunities that are part of our community. Free membership to the University of Melbourne gymnasium and swimming pool is also included.


## **Application Process**

Applications are welcome from those studying at, or conducting research at, The University of Melbourne. A small number of applicants are also accepted from students at RMIT University, ACU, and Monash University (Parkville Campus and City Campus). The College does not have an application closure date and accepts students at the beginning of each academic semester.
