Newman College is a Catholic University College, founded in 1918. The purpose of the College is to nurture the mind, the heart, the imagination and the spirit, so that its members can become effective leaders in the community, mature in belief and committed to justice.

Newman College is made up of around 300 students drawn from rural and regional Victoria, metropolitan Melbourne, and from interstate and overseas. With modern facilities, a comprehensive tutorial programme, student mentoring, and extensive scholarship and bursary programmes, Newman encourages a standard of excellence in studies. Extracurricular opportunities in sport, music, art, drama, and community service promote the variety of gifts in members of the College. The College's numerous functions, as well as social and cultural events, all play a part in developing an environment which fosters a supportive, engaged and critically aware community.

- Many students are supported by an extensive scholarship and bursary programme. This enables a significant cohort of students from all over Australia, as well as overseas, to attend the College.
- The Council of the College endeavours to keep the fees of the College as affordable as possible.
- Students are able to obtain part-time employment in the College.
- Students are not required to vacate their rooms during the mid-year break.
- Nearly a third of the student body is engaged in graduate and postgraduate studies. Graduates may remain in residence for the full calendar year.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications are welcome from any student who intends to enter, or is presently studying at, the University of Melbourne. A limited number of applications are also accepted from students intending to study at, or currently studying at, RMIT, Monash University (Pharmacy), and ACU.

CLOSE OF APPLICATIONS:

Newman College does not have an application closure date, but it is preferable to complete and submit your application by the end of November.

OFFERS OF RESIDENCY:

These are normally made when VTAC course offers are released. Students who are currently enrolled at the University of Melbourne, or who receive an early offer from the University, may be made an early offer for a place at the College.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES:

Last year, Newman College offered over 220 students either a scholarship or a bursary. Details about our scholarship and bursary offerings are on the College website.

FEES:

Our fees are on the website. The fees for next year will be available later on this year. We try and subsidise the fees across the board so that a number of students from rural and regional Australia can attend the College. Fees include residency for the academic year (including mid-year break), three daily meals, all utilities (including IT), and access to the College's academic, social, sporting, cultural and spiritual programs. Fees also includes access to the University of Melbourne's swimming pool and gym.
