Course Objectives:

The Cert III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30113) qualification reflects the role of Educators in a range of early childhood education settings who work within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standard. They support the implementation of an approved learning framework, and support children's wellbeing, learning and development. Depending on the setting, educators may work under direct supervision or autonomously.

WDEA Works Training provides affordable, practical, industry-based training and education that is:

A Working with Children check is a mandatory requirement prior to commencement. During placement, some centres may also require a Police Check.
